- 3. Website for Neighbors Against MCRSD is progressing
- 4. Recap of formation of MCRSD
- 5. Recap of estimated costs to abandon current septic system and hook up to sewer
 - \$6k -\$8k min
- 6. Reduced monthly fee to start at start of construction possibly 2yr before service
- 7. Waters not hazardous per MCRSD own printed material
- 8. Possible alternative septic systems approved in Marshall County
 - Aerobic Treatment Systems/Units (ATS/ATU)
 - Recirculating Sand Filter
 - Mound System
- 9. 20 yr cost comparison of new septic to sewer
 - New septic \$14,500 \$22,500
 - Sewer \$100/month service fee = \$31,000 \$44,000

\$200/month service fee = \$55,000 - \$68,000

- 10. Review comments from last board mtg made by JPR or MCRSD
 - Last date easement rights can be submitted (a week or so before the sewer gets to your house
 - Would a petition do any good to stop sewer NO
 - Possible lien on property and tax sale if you don't pay service fee
 - Can file for exemption but typically very few get them
- 11. Sewer system IS NOT mandated by Indiana Department of Environmental Management
- 12. MCRSD has spent about \$800k so far
- 13. Review County Commissioners mtg asked to remove Tom McFadden, Commissioners have to review all options before any decisions can be made
